Signs will be placed at primary intersections on Monday, and flushing will begin on **Tuesday, September 5** on *Seddon Court, Garfield, Burr, Harding, Curtis, and Eastbrook Drive*. Discolored water may occur temporarily in these or nearby areas as hydrants are opened. It is advised that residents avoid laundering clothing between 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM when flushing occurs in your immediate area. Iron and manganese may be stirred up in the system, but there is no health risk to the consumer.

Residents are reminded that this procedure is mandated by the Ohio EPA, and is necessary to maintain water quality in the distribution system.
