

ORDINANCE NO. 2-22

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO CONTRACTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS FOR THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council authorizes and directs the Mayor, Director of Public Service and Public Safety, to advertise for bids and enter into contracts for the purchase of the following hereinafter named supplies and materials for the City of Ashland, Ohio; and,


WHEREAS, this Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health and safety for the reason that it is immediately necessary to purchase said supplies and materials in order to provide for the efficient and effective operation of the City of Ashland, Ohio; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 4 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into contracts for the purchase of the following hereinafter named supplies and materials for the City of Ashland, Ohio, the quantities being more or less as stated herein as shown by "Exhibit A", attached hereto and made a part hereof, and conforming with the more detailed specifications on file in the office of the Engineering Division.

Section 2. That for the reason that it is immediately necessary to purchase said supplies and materials in order to provide for the efficient and effective operation of the City of Ashland, Ohio, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health and safety of the City of Ashland, Ohio, and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
