

Ordinance No. 23 22

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT FOR THE STREET DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, replacement equipment is immediately required for the continued effective and efficient operation of the Street Department of the City of Ashland, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure the continued effective and efficient administration of the City of Ashland, Ohio and the orderly completion of the above-mentioned equipment purchase, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety, and welfare of said City; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of the following equipment for the Street Department of the City of Ashland, Ohio, said purchase to be made without the necessity of formal advertising and bidding, due to equipment being purchased through an existing O.D.O.T. Co-operative Purchasing Contract:

Contract No. O-23-21


One (1) 2023 Freightliner M2106 L9 Cummins Plow Truck at a cost of \$172,000.00

Section 2. That the money for said equipment be paid from Account No. 101-2901-58055.




