

ORDINANCE NO. 30-22

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT FOR THE DIVISION OF FIRE OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO; OBTAINING FORMAL ADVERTISING AND BIDDING; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council deems it necessary and advisable to immediately purchase equipment for the Division of Fire of the City of Ashland, Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the equipment herein specified is immediately needed in order to provide for the continued efficient and effective operation of the Division of Fire of said City of Ashland, Ohio, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio 5 members there to concurring:

Section 1. That the Mayor be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of the following equipment for the Division of Fire of the City of Ashland, Ohio, obviating formal advertising and bidding, due to the purchase being through the existing State Cooperative purchasing agreement contract, or per House Bill 204


One (1) 2022 Ford F-550 4X4 chassis fitted with a Road Rescue medic module. With a total cost not to exceed \$329,000.00


Section 2. That the money for said equipment be paid out of the 222 fund in a method as determined by the Finance Director in accordance with the Division of Fire Vehicle Replacement program.

Section 3. That for reasons that the equipment herein specified is immediately needed in order to provide for the continued efficient and effective operation of the Division of Fire of the City of Ashland, Ohio this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately needed for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio.


Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
