

ORDINANCE NO. 31-22

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE VEHICLE INTERLOCK ALCOHOL MONITORING FUND 262 TO THE INDIGENT DRIVERS ALCOHOL TREATMENT FUND 249 IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$15,000.00); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ashland Municipal Court has issued an order authorizing and directing the transfer of funds from the Vehicle Interlock Alcohol Monitoring Fund 262 to the Indigent Drivers Alcohol Treatment Fund 249; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to affirm the transfer of funds from the Vehicle Interlock Alcohol Monitoring Fund 262 to the Indigent Drivers Alcohol Treatment Fund 249 in the amount of Fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00); now therefore

Be It Ordained, by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the following transfer of funds for the calendar year 2022 for the City of Ashland, to offset operating cost, be and the same is hereby affirmed and directed to be made as follows:

Transferring – Fifteen Thousand dollars (\$15,000.00).


From Fund 262 Vehicle Interlock Alcohol Monitoring Fund – Expenses


To Fund 249 Indigent Drivers Alcohol Treatment Fund – Fines




