

ORDINANCE NO. 35-22

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE CENTER RUN TRAIL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT IN THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, via Resolution No. 6-18, Council authorized the Mayor, Director of Public Service of the City of Ashland, to file applications and to enter into agreements with the Ohio Public Works Commission for the purpose of acquiring funds through the Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Program pursuant to Section 164 of the Ohio Revised Code for the Center Run Trail Project in the City of Ashland, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the agreement with the Ohio Public Works Commission has been signed and the project construction plans and specifications have been completed; and

WHEREAS, for the reason that the provision for the Center Run Trail Improvements Project is necessary in order to meet Grantor's timeframe, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, five (5) members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Mayor, Director of Public Service be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the Center Run Trail Improvements Project in accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the City Engineer.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to eliminate any or all of the above improvements from the above project if he shall determine that same shall be in the best interest of the City of Ashland.


Section 3. That the engineering estimate for said project is forty-eight thousand four hundred fifty-six dollars (\$48,456.00). Thirty-six thousand three hundred forty-two dollars (\$36,342.00) of said costs shall be provided for via OPWC disbursement requests paid directly to the contractor. The City's share of the project costs shall be twelve thousand one hundred fourteen dollars (\$12,114.00), which have been appropriated to be paid from Account No. 405-4697-55125.

Section 4. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into contract modifications not exceeding 10% of the contract amount for contingency items deemed necessary due to unforeseen existing conditions.


Section 5. That for the reason that the Center Run Trail Improvements Project is immediately necessary in order to meet Grantor’s timeframe, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland.

Section 6. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.

RESOLUTION NO. 6-18

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO FILE AN APPLICATION AND ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING FUNDS THROUGH THE CLEAN OHIO GREEN SPACE CONSERVATION PROGRAM FOR THE CENTER RUN TRAIL PROJECT IN THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission provides financial assistance through the Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Program for eligible projects; and

WHEREAS, eligible projects include those projects that protect and enhance riparian corridors or watersheds, including the protection of streams, rivers, lakes, and other bodies of water; and,

WHEREAS, this Council supports the proposed Center Run Trail Project, which would protect and enhance the riparian corridor of Center Run Creek; and,

WHEREAS, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety, and welfare, and for the further reason that the Application must be submitted by June 8, 2018; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of Ashland, Ohio, is hereby authorized to apply to the Ohio Public Works Commission for Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Program funds for the Center Run Trail Project.


Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of Ashland, Ohio, is hereby authorized to enter into any agreements with the Ohio Public Works Commission as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining financial assistance to complete said project, as indicated in its application.

Section 3. That for the reason that the Application herein specified must be submitted by June 8, 2018, in order to secure funding for the completion of said project, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio.


