

ORDINANCE NO. 14-22

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ENVIRO-FLOW PIPE & CONDUIT SERVICES, LTD. FOR THE LINING OF A PORTION OF FAILING SANITARY SEWER MAIN ALONG MORGAN AVENUE IN THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, multiple sinkholes have developed within Morgan Avenue due to failing joints along a section of sanitary sewer main located within the roadway; and

WHEREAS, the installation of a cured in place pipe lining (CIPP), a trenchless technology, is best suited to remediate the failing sewer due to existing sewer depth and location within the center of Morgan Avenue; and

WHEREAS, for the reason that this work is immediately necessary to remediate impacts to the public roadway, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, five (5) members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Mayor, Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the lining of a portion of sanitary sewer main along Morgan Avenue (350-feet), obviating formal advertising and bidding, due to a public emergency in accordance with ORC 735.051.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to eliminate any or all of the above improvements from the above project if he shall determine that same shall be in the best interest of the City of Ashland.


Section 3. That the cost for said contract is sixty four thousand seven hundred dollars (\$64,700.00). Said money has been appropriated to be paid from Account No. 611-7201-55012.

Section 4. That for the reason that this work is immediately necessary to remediate impacts to the public roadway, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio
