

ORDINANCE NO. 86-22

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE 2023 TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO TO MEET THE ORDINARY EXPENSES OF SAID CITY AND PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 5705.38; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Ashland, Ohio, elects to postpone the passage of its annual appropriations ordinance until such time as an amended certificate is received based on its actual cash balances and pursuant to the authority granted to it by the Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.38; and

WHEREAS, for that reason it is immediately necessary to meet the ordinary expenses of said City, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare, now therefore,


NOW THEREFORE be it ordained by the Council of the City of Ashland Ohio 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated by this Council of the City of Ashland, Ohio, pursuant to the authority granted to it by the Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.38, a temporary appropriation measure, creating sufficient monies necessary to meet the ordinary expenses of said City until such time as the annual appropriations ordinance can be approved, but not later than March 31, 2023 said ongoing ordinary expenses defined as being set forth as only those expenditures need to keep the city in operation.

Section 2. For that this reason it is immediately necessary to meet said operating expenses of the City of Ashland, Ohio, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
