

RESOLUTION: 4-22

A resolution authorizing the filing of (an) application(s) with the Ohio Department of Transportation by the City of Ashland for grants through the US DOT Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and the State of Ohio, as authorized under Federal Transit Laws and State of Ohio laws executing a contract with the Ohio Department of Transportation upon project approval; and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation is authorized to make grants for the US DOT Federal Transit Administration (FTA) funds and the State of Ohio;

WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the applicant, including the provision by it of the local share of the project costs in the program;

WHEREAS, it is required by the U.S. Department of Transportation in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, that in connection with the filing of an application for assistance the applicant gives an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the U.S. Department of Transportation requirements thereunder; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of Ashland is authorized on behalf of


- a. to execute and file
 - i. Proposals to aid in the financing of capital, operating and planning assistance projects
 - ii. Grant agreements with the Ohio Department of Transportation for aid in the financing of capital, operating and planning assistance projects
 - iii. An assurance or any other document required by the U.S. Department of Transportation effectuating the purposes of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; and
 - iv. Set forth affirmative disadvantage business policies in connection to any procurement made as part of the project

Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of Ashland is authorized to furnish such additional information as the Ohio Department of Transportation may require in connection with the proposal for the program of projects submitted to the Federal Transit Administration and the State of Ohio.




