

RESOLUTION NO. 9-22

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, TO FILE APPLICATIONS AND ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING FUNDS THROUGH THE STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM AND THE LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM PURSUANT TO SECTION 164 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE FOR THE COMPLETION OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS IN THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Ashland is planning to make capital improvements involving the replacement of an existing culvert along Valentine Valley Drive and the replacement of an existing traffic signal and appurtenances at the US-42/Mifflin Avenue intersection; and,

**WHEREAS**, the infrastructure improvements herein above described are considered to be priority needs for the community and are qualified activities under the Ohio Public Works Commission programs; and,

**WHEREAS**, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety, and welfare, and for the further reason that the agreements are needed in order to secure funds for the completion of these projects for the convenience of the citizens of said City of Ashland, Ohio; now therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

**Section 1.** That the Mayor of the City of Ashland, Ohio, is hereby authorized to apply for and, if awarded, enter into any agreements with the Ohio Public Works Commission as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining financial assistance to complete said projects, as indicated in each application.


**Section 2.** That for the reason that the agreements herein specified are immediately needed in order to secure funding for the completion of the projects for the convenience of the City of Ashland, Ohio, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure


