

ORDINANCE NO. 11-23

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SIGNAL SERVICE COMPANY FOR THE MIFFLIN/CLAREMONT AVENUE TRAFFIC SIGNAL DETECTION UPGRADE PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the existing video detection equipment at the Mifflin/Claremont traffic signal requires replacement in order for the City of Ashland to provide effective and efficient transportation infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, that for the reason that this Project is immediately necessary to provide for efficient and effective operation of said traffic signal, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, five (5) members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Mayor, Director of Public Service be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Signal Services Company for the Mifflin/Claremont Avenue Traffic Signal Detection Upgrade Project, in accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the City Engineer.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to eliminate any or all of the above improvements from the above project if he shall determine that same shall be in the best interest of the City of Ashland.

Section 3. That the contract cost for said project is forty thousand four hundred thirty-four dollars (\$40,434.00). Project costs will be appropriated to be paid from Account No. 206-1401-55501.


Section 4. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into contract modifications not exceeding 10% of the contract amount for contingency items deemed necessary due to unforeseen existing conditions.

Section 5. That for the reason that this Project is immediately necessary to provide for efficient and effective operation of said traffic signal, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio


