

ORDINANCE NO. 25-23

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE, TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE EQUALIZATION BASIN INFLUENT METERING MODIFICATIONS PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to modify the metering system for influent to the Water Pollution Control Facility's Equalization Basin in order to meet National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit requirements; and

WHEREAS, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to complete said Project within the timeline specified within said NPDES Permit, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety, and welfare of said City; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, five (5) members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Mayor, Director of Public Service be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to advertise for bids and to enter into a contract for the Equalization Basin Influent Metering Modification Project, in accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the City Engineer.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to eliminate any or all of the above improvements from said Project if he shall determine the same shall be in the best interest of the City of Ashland.


Section 3. That Engineer's Estimate for said Project is one hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$130,000.00). Project costs have been appropriated to be paid from Account No. 611-7201-55012.

Section 4. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into contract modifications not exceeding 10% of the contract amount for contingency items deemed necessary due to unforeseen existing conditions.


Section 5. That for the reason that it is immediately necessary to complete said Project within the timeline specified within said NPDES Permit, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of the City of Ashland.

Section 6. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
