

ORDINANCE NO. 36-23

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO TRANSFER FUNDS FROM THE DRUG LAW ENFORCEMENT FUND 242 TO THE OPIOID REHAB FUND 271. THE TRANSFER WILL BE IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY THOUSAND, THREE HUNDRED AND TWENTY FIVE DOLLARS AND FOURTEEN CENTS (\$20,325.14), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ashland City Council has Authorized the creation of the Opioid Rehab Fund 271; and

WHEREAS, the Auditor of States office has authorized the creation of the Opioid Rehab Fund 271; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance requests authorization to transfer funds in the amount of twenty thousand, three hundred and twenty-five dollars and fourteen cents. from the Drug Law Enforcement Fund to the Opioid Rehab Fund 271; now therefore

Be It Ordained, by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the following transfer of funds for the calendar year 2023 for the City of Ashland, to offset the project cost, be and the same is hereby affirmed and directed to be made as follows:

Transferring – Twenty Thousand, Three Hundred and Twenty-Five Dollars and Fourteen Cents (\$20,325.14).


From Fund 242 Drug Law Enforcement Fund – 242-8501-58085 Operating Costs


To Fund 271 Opioid Rehab Fund – 271-0004-40700 Grant Receivable

Section 2. To meet the City of Ashland, Ohio's immediate financial needs, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for preserving the public peace, property, health, and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.
