NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed bids, properly endorsed, for the furnishing of all necessary labor and materials for:

Cleveland Avenue Bridge Repair Project

will be received at the office of the Ashland City Engineering Division, Municipal Building, 206 Claremont Avenue, Ashland, Ohio, **until 2:00 p.m., local time, May 18, 2018**, and then at said office opened and evaluated in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 9.28. An apparent low bidder will be announced but bid amounts won't be released until such time that a contract is awarded.

A pre-bid meeting will be held on **May 14, 2018 at 10:00 a.m., local time**, at the office of the Ashland City Engineering Division. Attendance is **OPTIONAL**.

Copies of the bid package may be obtained from the City of Ashland Engineering Division, 206 Claremont Avenue, Ashland, Ohio 44805. Copies may be obtained only upon payment of **twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)** for each set. To obtain copies by mail, please send a separate check for **fifteen dollars (\$15.00)** for postage and handling, to the aforesaid address. Make all checks payable to the City of Ashland, Ohio. The deposit is non-refundable. **Each Holder of bidder documents MUST be recorded with the City PRIOR to bid opening.**

Each bidder is required to furnish with its bid, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said Surety.

Each bid must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity. The Owner intends and requires that this project be completed within **90 days** of the contract being awarded.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable use Ohio Products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of the project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

"DOMESTIC STEEL USE REQUIREMENTS AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 453.11 OF THE REVISED CODE APPLY TO THIS PROJECT. COPIES OF SECTION 153.011 OF THE REVISED CODE CAN BE OBTAINED FROM ANY OF THE OFFICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES."

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Ashland County and the City of Ashland as determined by the Ohio Department of Commerce, Wage and Hour Division, 614-644-2239.
