**NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS**

Sealed bids, properly endorsed, for the furnishing of all necessary labor and materials for:

**2018 Street Resurfacing Program**

**Work consists of the resurfacing of various streets in the City of Ashland. Project will include, asphalt pavement planing of existing surface and asphalt overlay;**

will be received at the office of the Ashland City Engineering Division, Municipal Building, Third Floor, 206 Claremont Avenue, Ashland, Ohio, **until 2:00 p.m., local time, April 20, 2018**, and at that time will be publicly opened and read aloud in the City Council Chambers.

A pre-bid meeting will be held on **April 16, 2018, at 11:00 a.m.** in the City Council Chambers. Attendance is **OPTIONAL**.

Copies of the bid package may be obtained from the City of Ashland, Engineering Division, 206 Claremont Avenue, Ashland, Ohio 44805. Copies may be obtained only upon payment of **Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00)** for each set. To obtain copies by mail, send a separate check for **Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)** for postage and handling, to the aforesaid address. Make all checks payable to the City of Ashland, Ohio. The deposit is not refundable. **Each Holder of Bidder Documents MUST be recorded with the Owner PRIOR to bid opening.**

Each bidder is required to furnish with its bid, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

Each Bid must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the bid and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of experience on projects of similar size and complexity. The owner intends and requires that this project be completed no later than **September 28, 2018.**

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable use Ohio Products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of the project.

Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Ashland County and the City of Ashland, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Department of Industrial Relations.

The right is reserved to accept or reject any and all bids and award the contract on the basis determined by the City of Ashland to be the best bid.
