

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING #2  
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG)  
DIRECT ALLOCATION/CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE/  
NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION PROGRAM GRANTS**

**May 21, 2019 at 7:10 p.m.**

The City of Ashland will apply to the Ohio Development Services Agency for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Direct Allocation Program, a federally funded program administered by the State of Ohio. The City is eligible for approximately **\$150,000** of Direct Allocation Program Year 2019 CDBG funding. The City will also be applying for competitive set-aside programs including **\$500,000** through the Critical Infrastructure Program and **\$750,000** through the Neighborhood Revitalization Program. On March 19, 2019, the City conducted its first public hearing to inform citizens about the CDBG program opportunities. The City also held a Community Development Implementation Strategy (CDIS) public meeting on April 8, 2019.

On **May 21, 2019**, the City will conduct its second public hearing to inform citizens of the programs and applicable projects for each program which have been selected:

- Direct Allocation Program Year 2019
  - Union Street/ East 8<sup>th</sup> Street Resurfacing Project - \$100,500
  - West 10<sup>th</sup> Street Resurfacing Project - \$25,000
  - Brookside Park Band Shell ADA Access Improvement Project - \$15,500
  - Preparation of an *Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice Study* - \$6,000
  - Fair Housing Program Costs - \$3,000
- Critical Infrastructure Program
  - Claremont Avenue Bridge Replacement Project – \$470,000
  - Administrative Costs - \$30,000
- Neighborhood Revitalization Program
  - Buckeye/Marlo Neighborhood Revitalization Project - \$720,000
  - Administrative Costs - \$30,000

The national objective of each project will be announced at the meeting.

Citizens and community stakeholders are encouraged to attend this meeting to express their views and comments on the City's proposed applications. The meeting will be held in the City Council Chambers (Ashland City School District Administrative Offices) located at 1407 Claremont Avenue, Ashland, Ohio on May 21, 2019, at 7:10pm, as part of the regular City Council Meeting.
