

PHYSICAL ABILITY EXAM WAIVER

The job of Police Officer can be a very physical job. Police Officers must be in good physical shape for their safety as well as being able to perform the duties and responsibilities of the position. The Physical Ability Exam is designed to determine if the candidate for the position of Police Officer has the minimum acceptable level of fitness and ability to perform the physical tasks that have been determined to be critical to the position.

CAUTION: If you have any reason to believe that you are not in good health or if you have not had a recent medical examination, you should talk to your physician BEFORE you take this Physical Ability Exam.

I agree that if at any time during the Physical Ability Exam I experience shortness of breath, chest discomfort or pain, jaw discomfort or pain, joint pain, feel sick to my stomach, or any other symptoms of over-exertion, illness, or distress, I will stop performing the activity and immediately notify the preceptor.

I further agree not to hold the City of Ashland and the Division of Police and any of their agents liable for any illness or injury that is a result of the Physical Ability Exam.
