

ORDINANCE NO. 15-22

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF CUSTOMIZABLE, STATE SPECIFIC LAW ENFORCEMENT POLICY AND TRAINING SOLUTIONS SOFTWARE THAT SHALL CONTINUALLY UPDATED IN RESPONSE TO NEW STATE AND FEDERAL LAWS AND COURT DECISIONS FOR THE POLICE DIVISION OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OHIO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, this Council deems it necessary and advisable to immediately purchase law enforcement policy and training solutions software for the Police Division of the City of Ashland, Ohio; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the law enforcement policy and training solutions are immediately needed in order to provide for the continued efficient and effective operation of the Division of Police of said City of Ashland, Ohio, now therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Ashland, State of Ohio, 5 members thereto concurring:

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor be, and is hereby, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of law enforcement policy and training solutions software for the Police Division of the City of Ashland, Ohio, obviating formal advertising and bidding, due to the purchase price of the policy and training solutions being a cost effective resolution to help the Division of Police enhance compliance, professionalism and transparency and said price being below the threshold established by Revised Code Section 735.05.

**State specific law enforcement policy and training solutions software not to exceed a total of \$30,000 for fiscal year 2022.**


**SECTION 2.** That the money for said software shall be paid out of the **267 Police 60 Fund** in a method as determined by the Director of Finance.

**SECTION 3.** That for the reason that the software herein specified is immediately needed in order to provide for the continued efficient and effective operation of the Division of Police of the City of Ashland, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure

immediately needed for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of said City of Ashland, Ohio.

**SECTION 4.** That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval pursuant to Section 12 of the Charter of the City of Ashland, Ohio.


